# 7 Vikings Garner All-Com Z Berths; U.K. Stars Picked

WITH THE matmen and eagers pushing for the spotlight, we close our files on the 1965 USDESEA gridiron season by announcing The Stars and Stripes all-Com Z and All-U.K. Division teams. Thanks to many eager-to-help coaches and school officials in Germany, France, England, Spain and Italy, all-star teams from all eight USDESEA football leagues were selected and mailed to us for publication this year.

Coach John Manzoline's Dreux Vikings head the 23-man Com Z squad. The Vikings, who won three of five games to finish in a second-place tie with the Paris Pirates, had seven players—five on defense—selected. The Pirates placed four boys on the offensive squad and two on the defensive unit. The Orleans Knights, who won the league title with a 4-0 record, also nailed down six spots — three on each team. The offensive team is made up of 12 players because Carl Steiner of Dreux, Wes Evans of Verdun and Frank Burras of Paris all received an equal number of votes for the two halfback spots.

London Central dominates the All-U.K. team. Only one team—a 13-player contingent — was selected because of the size (two schools) of the division. Coach Taylor Lewis' London boys, who won the league title by beating Lakenheath by 8-6 in the third and deciding encounter of the season between the two schools, filled all but four of the spots on the team. The squad is headed by London halfback Max Jack, a 6-foot, 180-pounder, who ran for eight touchdowns and passed for four more in leading the Bobcats to a 5-2 season. The potent backfield also includes London quarterback Dale Christiansen, who passed for seven TDs, and fleet runners John Childress of Lakenheath and Bob Brandt of the Bobcats.
